Japan Sailing Federation


[1] In accordance with "PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT" signed between the Brazilian Olympic Committee and the Japan Olympic Committee on 18 08 2010 as attached, the Confederação Brasileira de Vela and the Japan Sailing Federation have agreed the following in field of sailing activities.

- a) Exchange of visits and joint-training between the national team
- b) Exchange of visits between officials, staff
- c) Exchange of Venue information
- d) Exchange of Logistic information (boat, container, storage and accommodation)
- e) Exchange of Marketing information


[2] In order to give effect to this Agreement, the parties will execute an annual Protocol of Exchange for each year of term of this Agreement. Each Protocol will document the intended activities to be undertaken during the forthcoming year.

[3] This Agreement becomes valid when signed and remains in effect until December 31, 2020. Should neither of the parties notify the other in writing six months before termination of this Agreement about changes to be made or cancel the Agreement altogether, it will remain in effect for the period.
